Introduction from Leanne Noren



What is Pierce County Project

Access? Many people have asked me that question over the past eight years. We are a small non-profit that exists to serve the low-income uninsured population of Pierce County. We work with people who need access to medical care but can't afford it and don't have health insurance.

When I begin to explain who we are and what we do, many are confused at the idea of a network of volunteer physicians and health systems partnering with us to have a coordinated, equitable distribution of donated care. I

think it's hard for most people to believe there are doctors

who would be happy to donate care to those who need help. We do live in such a community where over 670 clinicians participate in our network to voluntarily give of their time, talent and treasure for the neediest in our community.

Why are people uninsured? The Affordable Care Act and the State of Wash-

ington did increase insurance options through expanded Medicaid and yet gaps exist. We serve about 800 people per year through our two programs.








Community Highlight
