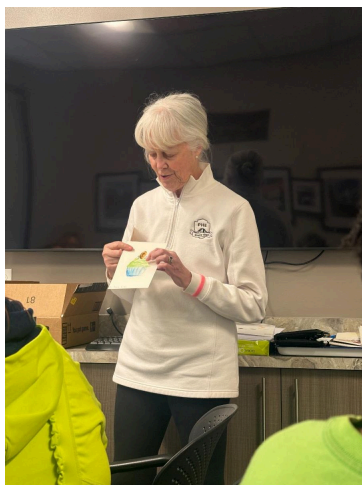

Federal Prescription Drug Portal

A new federal prescription drug pricing portal launched earlier this month to help consumers access select medications at significantly reduced cash-pay prices. The site acts as a central directory rather than a pharmacy—users can search for their medication and, when available, are directed to participating pharmaceutical manufacturers offering discounted prices through their own direct-to-consumer platforms. Initial offerings included roughly 40 high-cost branded medications, including treatments for diabetes, weight management, and fertility, all available at substantially lower cash prices. These reductions are made possible through negotiated agreements under a “Most Favored Nation” model, which ties U.S. prices for participating drugs to the lowest prices paid in comparable developed countries.

For individuals with health insurance, the benefits of this system may vary. Discounts apply only to cash-pay purchases and typically do *not* count toward insurance deductibles, meaning insured patients may still pay less when using their health plans. Analysts note that the portal is most beneficial for uninsured consumers or those

enrolled in high-deductible plans who often face higher out-of-pocket costs. Early evaluations also highlight that manufacturer participation remains limited and not all commonly used medications are included. As the program expands, the portal may become more useful, but for now it serves primarily as an optional comparison tool that may help certain consumers reduce prescription expenses depending on their coverage and needs. We recommend that consumers compare prices on the portal but carefully consider whether direct purchases are advantageous, since payments may not count toward out-of-pocket maximums and could ultimately cost more.

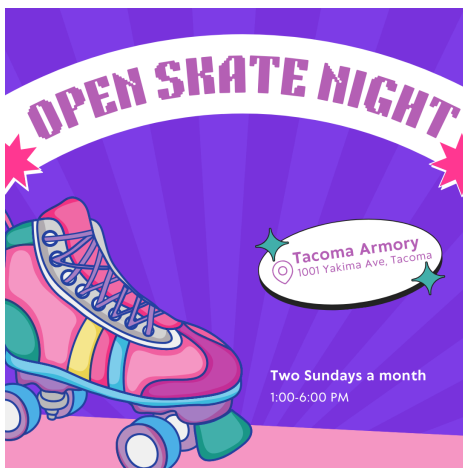


Onesie Fun Run

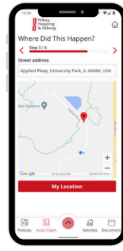
