They coordinate partnerships, manage projects, and foster collaboration to improve outcomes for kids across Washington. First 5 FUNdamentals helps ensure that every child and family—regardless of background—has access to the support they need to thrive.

Medicare Open Enrollment runs every year from October 15 to December 7, giving Medicare beneficiaries the opportunity to review and make changes to their coverage for the upcoming year. During this time, you can switch between Original Medicare and Medicare Advantage, change your Medicare Advantage plan, or adjust your Part D prescription drug plan. Any changes you make will take effect on January 1 of the following year.

It's important to review your plan each year because coverage, provider networks, and drug formularies can change. Even if you're happy with your current plan, take a few minutes to confirm that your doctors, hospitals, and medications will still be covered next year. Comparing plans may also help you find one with lower premiums or out-of-pocket costs. Also, watch for mail or email from insurance companies, as this is where they tell you whether doctors and prescriptions will be dropped from future plans.

We are here to help! We do not offer every option available, but our team is committed to showing you all the options so you can make the best choice for you. We are using a new technology this year called HealthSherpa that will allow us to help quicker. This tool will ask you to enter your prescription and sign the federally required scope of appointment form. If you have any issues with the technology, please let us know and we can assist or complete it manually. You also have the option of using resources such as Medicare.gov to compare plans on your own if you'd prefer. We may also direct you to this site to apply for coverage if we are not appointed with the company you choose.

Thank you for your business and we are looking forward to helping all of our Medicare beneficiaries through the Annual Election Period (AEP).




Haunted Farmers Market




